## Boone County Hall of Fame 2023 ENSHRINEES



### - Posthumous Recipient -Charles Morgenthaler

Renowned artist Charles Morgenthaler (1893–1980) was born in Hallsville. He graduated from Columbia High School and then enrolled at the Art Institute of Chicago in 1915. World War I disrupted his lessons, but he finally finished in 1928. Morgenthaler volunteered to sketch servicemembers in World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War, drawing over 1,400 in all. He eventually returned to mid-Missouri where his legacy is well cared for; the Morgenthaler home has been restored and is the home of the Hallsville Historical Society. More than 200 of his works are preserved in the Boone County Historical Society art collection and 30 paintings are in the holdings of the State Historical Society.



### - Organization Recipient-

### The Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri

Through empowerment, education and partnerships, the Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri brings together community resources to feed people in need across 32 counties. The Food Bank has increased distribution more than 400 times over since their founding in 1981. Today they share the equivalent of more than 23 million meals with our neighbors each year. In Boone County alone, that adds up to 5,286,862 pounds of food given to those who need it most in a single year. Food is distributed through The Food Bank's network of partner agencies, including nearly 200 schools and 145+ food pantries, shelters and other agencies. Their VIP Veteran Pack Program has grown to serve 450 veterans on a monthly basis.



### -Living Recipient-Retired Colonel John Clark, USAF

Born in Columbia, John Clark is a 1957 graduate of Hickman High School. He entered the Air Force after graduating from the University of Missouri Engineering School. Clark trained as a pilot at Reese Air Force Base in Texas before assignments in New Jersey, South Carolina, England and Thailand. He flew 60+ missions over North Vietnam before he was downed by anti-aircraft fire in March 1967. Clark was captured and imprisoned for nearly six years. He used everything he had to survive—tapping into his courage, determination, faith and honor. Clark retired as a Colonel. He earned the Silver Star, two Legions of Merit, two Purple Hearts, the Distinguished Flying Cross, six Air Medals and more.

### **NOMINATION PROCESS**

Members of the Boone County Hall of Fame are recognized for their lasting contribution to the county, state and nation through their professional or philanthropic life. Each year one living recipient, one posthumous honoree and one business or organization are selected for enshrinement.

They are selected from a slate of nominations made by members in good standing of the Boone County Historical Society. Early each year a call for nominations and deadline for submissions is announced to ensure members have the opportunity to provide input into the enshrinees. The Boone County Historical Society Endowment Trust Selection Committee reviews all nominations and selects the Hall of Fame enshrinees. Enshrinees are then officially inducted into the Hall of Fame at the annual event, generally a gala in the fall.
